2015 – 2016 Graduate Degree Recipients by Level**

Executive Summary

- The Office of Institutional Research collected educational and career placement data for 2015-16 graduate degree recipients from numerous sources, including the New Alumni Online Survey, the New Alumni Phone Survey, graduation surveys (including surveys administered by Institutional Research, the Farmer School of Business, and the College of Engineering and Computing), the National Student Clearinghouse, public LinkedIn profiles, and Miami University's Banner data system. Results are based on alumni placement as of fall 2016.
- Educational placement data were available for 100% of alumni while career placement data (excluding those who were enrolled in graduate/professional school after graduation) were available for 67% of master's degree recipients and 87% of doctoral degree recipients. Information on alumni's current state/country of residence was obtained for 75% of master's alumni and 84% of doctoral alumni.

Combined Educational and Career Placement

- Among both master's degree and doctoral degree recipients, 98.0% were either employed or enrolled after graduation.
 - Placement for doctoral degree recipients is consistent with last year (98.1%), while placement for master's degree recipients has increased (from 95.9% last year).

Educational Placement

- 16.8% of master's alumni were enrolled in school.
 - 8.5% were enrolled in a doctoral level program, 3.4% in an master's level program, and 1.6% were pursuing additional undergraduate study.
- The number of doctoral degree alumni who were enrolled in school after graduation doubled this year (8.6%) compared to last year (4.3%).
 - 5.2% of the current doctoral alumni were enrolled as a non-degree-seeking graduate student. Enrollment details (e.g., level or type of program) were unavailable for the remaining 3.4% of enrolled alumni.

Career Placement

- Among graduate alumni who were not enrolled in graduate or professional school, 97.1% were employed.
 - 97.0% of master's alumni were employed (compared with 94.8% last year), including 2.5% who were self-employed or running their own business.
 - 97.9% of doctoral alumni were employed (compared to 98.1% last year), including 2.1% who were self-employed or running their own business.

- Doctoral alumni were more likely than master's alumni to be employed at a college or university. 78.9% of employed doctoral alumni worked at a college or university, compared with only 19.4% of employed master's alumni.
 - There was an increase this year in the percentage of alumni who were employed by a college or university; last year, only 65.0% of doctoral alumni and 18.4% of master's alumni worked at a college or university.
 - The most commonly held position for employed doctoral alumni this year was a post-doc (15.8%), followed by tenure-track faculty positions (10.5%).
- The majority of employed alumni held a position that required a college degree, with 94.6% of master's alumni and 100.0% of doctoral alumni reporting that their job required a college degree.
 - Among master's alumni, 31.5% were employed in a position that required a master's degree or higher while 60.8% were in a position that required a bachelor's degree.
 - Compared to last year, there was a decrease in the percentage of master's alumni whose job required a master's degree or higher (34.8% last year).
 - In comparison, 76.3% of doctoral alumni were in a position that required a doctoral or professional degree. An additional 13.2% were in a position that required a master's degree, and 5.3% held a position that required a bachelor's degree.
 - Compared to last year, there was an increase in the percentage of doctoral alumni whose job required a doctoral or professional degree (68.9% last year).

State/Country of Residence

- Overall, there was a decrease this year in the percentage of graduate alumni who resided in Ohio after graduation; 49.2% of 2015-16 graduate alumni live in Ohio compared with 55.1% of 2014-15 alumni.
- Similar to last year, master's degree recipients were more likely than doctoral degree recipients to live in Ohio after graduation; 50.3% of master's alumni live in Ohio while 38.8% of doctoral alumni reside in Ohio.
- The percentage of master's alumni who move to a foreign country after graduation is consistent with last year (2.5% for current alumni compared with 2.3% of alumni last year).
- However, the percentage of doctoral alumni who reside in foreign country after graduation has nearly doubled; 10.2% of current doctoral alumni live in a foreign country compared with 5.2% of alumni last year.
 - Canada is the most frequently identified foreign residence for doctoral alumni (4.1%)
